Customer Activity:

Request for a new gas service.

Request permits for plumbing permit and installation of gas lines

If gas pressure requirements are greater than standard (inches of water column) then an elevated gas pressure permit is required.

Schedule and be available for onsite visit by Long Beach Gas & oil Inspection to “size the meter,” layout initial service line routing, and discuss fees

Schedule and be available for onsite visit by your building inspector for plumbing permit review.

Discuss Placement of telephone line for Electric Metering Equipment – fee required in advance

Discuss deposit requirement.

Complete financial review process, satisfy that all fees have been paid, etc.

If necessary, schedule and be available for onsite visit to turn on gas meter and light pilot lights.
