HACLB Office Will Be Closed to the Public Until Further Notice

The Housing Authority of the City of Long Beach is implementing the following temporary measures to help prevent the spread of COVID-19, or Coronavirus until further guidelines are released.

Effective [Monday, March 16, 2020](#), our agency lobby office will be closed to the public, all non-urgent, non-emergency work orders and housing quality standards inspections will be suspended with the exception of initial inspections where the unit is vacant and emergency inspections.
