

## Long Beach Continuum of Care Subcommittees

The Long Beach Continuum of Care invites you to participate in any of its three standing subcommittees: Policies and Standards, Coordinated Entry System, and Quality, Data, and Performance. Subcommittee membership is open to all general members of the Continuum of Care. Members are defined as anyone who has attended at least one Continuum of Care General Meeting.

A subcommittee may develop a policy recommendation for the city or may implement new modes of cooperation among its members that will improve outcomes for city residents experiencing homelessness. Subcommittees will strive to set measurable goals for their work and will report at least semi-annually to the Long Beach CoC General Membership on their progress. Each subcommittee shall consist of a maximum of seven total members including the Chair(s).
