Enhanced Standard Precautions

EVERYONE MUST:



- Clean hands before entering room
- Clean hands when exiting room



PROVIDERS & STAFF MUST ALSO:



- Wear gown and gloves during high contact resident care activities

Enhanced Standard Precautions



The 6 Moments of Enhanced Standard Precautions

1. Morning & Evening Care
2. Toileting & changing incontinence briefs
3. Caring for devices, giving medical treatments
4. Wound Care
5. Mobility Assistance
6. Cleaning the Environment

These precautions should be used during high contact resident care activities when caring for residents with 1 or more of these high-risk characteristics for MDRO transmission and colonization, even if MDRO status is unknown:

- Functional Disability**
Totally dependent on others for assistance with activities of daily living (ADLs), for example ambulation, bathing, dressing, grooming, eating, toileting.
- Incontinence**
Habitual soiling with stool and/or wetting with urine
- Presence of indwelling devices**
Urinary catheter, feeding tube, tracheostomy tube, vascular catheters
- Ventilator-dependence**
- Wounds or presence of pressure ulcer (unhealed)**
