### HOW TO QUALIFY FOR A C&D DEPOSIT REFUND? LET'S GET STARTED!

#### Step 1: PAY C&D RECYCLING DEPOSIT

Pay deposit during the permit issuance process.

#### Step 2: RECYCLE CONSTRUCTION MATERIALS

Choose a recycle facility from the list of approved C&D Compliant Recycle facilities. You are responsible for notifying the facility that you are recycling for the City of Long Beach C&D Program. Confirm that the material will be treated as C&D recyclable debris. The program requires applicants to self-haul material(s) or to use a waste hauler that is permitted to haul within the City of Long Beach. The use of any hauler not listed is out of compliance with the C&D Program and may result in the deposit being forfeited. For a list of licensed haulers and certified C&D diversion facilities, visit the City website by using the QR code or link above.

#### Step 3: RETAIN RECYCLE RECEIPTS/REPORTS

Retain all weight receipts/reports as evidence that construction debris has been diverted to an approved C&D compliant recycle facility. Each recycle receipt must include the following details; Long Beach as origin of recycled material, Tonnage or Quantity recycled/diverted, Material Type(s), Dated on/after the Permit Issuance date. It is the responsibility of the Owner/Contractor to ensure all required information is clearly stated on the recycle receipts. **Important:** Receipts labeled with terms such as "REFUSE", "MSW", "WASTE", "TRASH" will not be accepted, as only recycled materials qualify for compliance. Illegal dumping on public and private property is punishable by a fine up to \$10,000 or jail time for up to six months pursuant to the California Penal Code Section 374.3.

#### Step 4: SUBMIT C&D RECYCLE DEPOSIT PACKAGE

Submit your C&D Management Plan/Final Compliance form and recycle receipts within 90 days of your project's Final Inspection. Email all required documents to [Construct-Demo@longbeach.gov](mailto:Construct-Demo@longbeach.gov). Deposit refunds are issued by check and processing time is approximately 6 to 8 weeks. Failure to submit the required documentation within the prescribed 90 days, or failure to comply with the project requirements, will result in forfeiture of the performance deposit as outlined in LBMC, Section 18.67.070 (C) (2).

## Where Do I Submit My Documentation?

Submit the Final Compliance Report and the appropriate recycling receipts, within 90 days of the project completion, by email at: [construct-demo@longbeach.gov](mailto:construct-demo@longbeach.gov), or in person at the Development Permit Center located at Long Beach City Hall, 411 W. Ocean Blvd., 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor.

- Projects that meet the 65% diversion requirement will receive 100% reimbursement of their deposit.
- Projects that do not meet the 65% diversion requirement will receive a partial return of their deposit in proportion to the actual materials diverted.
- If all required documentation is not received within the prescribed 90 days after final inspection or if it is determined that diversion of waste was not achieved, the waste diversion deposit shall be forfeited.

## What if my project does not have any recyclables?

Exemptions to the C&D Program may be granted based on the following considerations:

- An emergency situation exists.
- Contamination by hazardous substances.
- Low recyclability of specific materials.

# Construction & Demolition

## What is the C&D Recycling Program?



The City of Long Beach Construction and Demolition (C&D) Recycling Program encourages the use of green building techniques for new construction, and promotes the reuse of recyclable materials for demolition and construction projects. The program requires applicants of certain construction projects to provide a waste diversion deposit (deposit) at the time of permit issuance, which is returned upon project completion and proof of recycling.

### Does this apply to my project?

The C&D program applies to the following projects:

- All newly constructed buildings or structures.
- Residential additions or alterations of existing residential buildings where there is an increase of the building's conditioned area, volume or size.
- Non-residential additions and alterations whenever a building permit is required for work.
- All demolition projects of any valuation.

### What is the process?

At the time of issuance, applicants are required to submit a deposit of either 3% of the project value or \$56,999, whichever is less. The minimum deposit is \$1,712 per project.

Applicants are also required to pay a non-refundable administrative review fee of either \$230.00 for residential projects or \$454.00 for commercial/industrial projects.

### How do I get my refund?

At the completion of the project, the applicant shall submit the completed and signed C&D Management Plan/Final Compliance Report with the following information:

- **Proof that C&D materials were taken to a diversion facility that processes and recycles mixed construction debris. For the nearest facility, visit: [longbeach.gov/lbds/building/cd/](http://longbeach.gov/lbds/building/cd/).**
- Recycling receipts indicating:
  - Long Beach as origin of recycled material.
  - Tonnage or quantity recycled/diverted.
  - Material type(s).

You must inform your permitted hauler or the facility that the material is to be recycled and provide your receipts to the City of Long Beach within 90 days of the project completion to receive the deposit.

**IMPORTANT:** The City will not accept receipts that indicate "REFUSE." Material(s) must be recycled. In addition, hauler's receipts will not be accepted. The program also requires the applicant to either self-haul material(s) or to use a waste hauler that is permitted to haul within the City of Long Beach. The use of any hauler not listed is out of compliance with the C&D Program and may result in the deposit being forfeited.
