Proposed Project: Certificate of Appropriateness (COA) application to allow for temporary removal, preservation and relocation of the Historic Dolly Varden Rooftop Sign which is a locally designated historic landmark sign located at 335 Pacific Avenue in the Downtown Plan (PD-30) Planned Development District. There is a separate Site Plan Review application 2212-09 (SPR22-135), which is not before this body or the subject of this hearing, to allow for the demolition of the existing hotel building, for the purpose of constructing a new 141-unit multi-family residential building with parking and resident amenity spaces within an 8-story (above-grade) structure and 2 levels of below grade parking at 335 Pacific Avenue. This public hearing is for the same project that the Cultural Heritage Commission (CHC) continued to a date uncertain on May 30, 2023, and for which a study session was held at the June 27, 2023, CHC meeting where the eligibility of the existing hotel building as a locally designated historic landmark was studied. There is no nomination for landmark designation for the existing hotel building and City staff has not identified the property as eligible for landmark designation (District 1)
