3	<b>Mandatory workshop for applicants proceeding with applications</b>	<b>Saturday, February 21, 2026</b>
4	<b>Application form and pre-application fee due to City</b>	<b>Friday, March 20, 2026</b>
5	Pre-contract property inspections conducted by City Staff	March – April 2026
6	Cultural Heritage Commission recommendation hearing	On or before Tuesday, July 1, 2026
7	City Council Hearing	On or before August 1, 2026
8	City notifies applicants of final selection	On or before October, 2026
9	City issues draft contracts to selected applicants	November 2026
10	Selected applicants return executed contract and application fee to City	December 2026
11	City executes and records contract with County Recorder	On or before December 31, 2026

## 2026 Mills Act Valuation

Property Type	Valuation Limit
Single Family Residential (1 dwelling unit)	Valuation less than \$1,718,912
Duplex or Triplex Residential (2 or 3 dwelling units)	Valuation less than \$1,031,477 per dwelling unit.
Multifamily Residential or Mixed Residential/Commercial (4 or more dwelling units)	No valuation limit.
Non-Residential (Commercial, Industrial, or Institutional)	Valuation less than \$4,447,694
(All Property Types – exceptional properties, culturally significant, or properties at risk of demolition)	No valuation limit – 2 contracts may be awarded.
