REQUIREMENTS

- Be at least 50 years of age
- Have no felony convictions
- Be in good physical health
- Be of good moral character
- Ability to volunteer at least 20 hours per month
- Valid California driver's license and vehicle
- Have basic computer and smartphone skills
- Pass a comprehensive background check
- Complete 40 hours of SPP academy training
