Responsibilities

- Work with the Sustainability Coordinator to complete GIS projects as directed. Projects planned for Summer 2021 include:
 - Urban forest and watersheds mapping and analysis
- Analyze GIS data to provide reports for programs as needed.

Requirements

- At least junior standing with a GPA of 3.0 or higher
- Pursuing a degree in a related field (Geography, Environmental Science/Policy, Public Administration/Policy etc.)
- Available to work a minimum of 10 hours per week during regular M-F 9-5 work schedule
- Familiar with GIS software and data analysis
